INTRODUCTION:

Jude doesn't need to bring out any more what these false pastors are like:

TRUE / FALSE ? *Cross out wrong one*

The word pictures used by Jude here are images of when things: *Tick the right box*

a) are not right in ourselves [] b) are not right in the world around us []

The first part of v12 shows this death and barrenness in the W..... place for it to be

1 – NOTICE WHERE THEY ARE!

The "love feast" was a time when they joined the spiritual meal with a P..... meal

1st Cor 11 tells of when the love feast became one's own feast: TRUE / FALSE ?

The word "blemish" is to be preferred here because it is something:

a) which stands out obviously [] b) which is hidden and can't be seen []

You always notice someone who is F..... of themselves!

Not having the "slightest qualm" means they feel guilty: TRUE / FALSE ?

When visiting a family whose loved one is dying you should:

a) be solemn and listen to them [] b) smile and let them know you can help []

In Ezekiel ... : we read of Israel's shepherds who only take care of themselves

2 – NOTICE WHAT THEY ARE!

Jude uses four metaphors taken from N..... to show they take all and give nothing

Like passing clouds with no rain, the false teachers are just full of H..... air (2 Pet .. : ...)

To the orchardist these kind of trees are those trees he:

a) leaves for another year [] b) gives more fertiliser [] c) pulls out []

Proverbs ... : uses a similar word picture (Compare with Rev. 2:11; 20:6,14; 21:8)

Paul speaks of this in 1 Tim.5:6 with the widow who lives in P..... being dead

Jude mixes the physical with the moral when he C..... winds with shame

Can you be with these people and not get hurt? YES / NO ?

The last metaphor makes it clear how L..... those people are

They are like the blind guides leading the blind Jesus describes in Luke :

The allusion to Enoch is especially fitting because he:

a) lost his heavenly home by disobeying God [] b) gained heaven by obeying God []

Do you understand these four word pictures from nature? YES / NO ?

Which of these is true of you? You are:

a) carried along by the Holy Spirit [] b) going to a darkness that's black forever []
