INTRODUCTION:

What Jude has prepared the believers there for is something easy like getting in a car:
TRUE / FALSE ? *Cross out wrong one*

What those believers there will go through will: *Tick right box*

a) be over soon [] b) really shake them up [] c) take a lot out of them []

1 – JUDE EXPOSES THE DANGER IN THIS THREAT

By using the phrase “certain men” Jude tells us they are E.....

Their secretly slipping in would remind the believers of the Lord’s Parable of:

a) The Lost Coin [] b) The Weeds [] c) The Talents []

All churches today preach that you’re only saved through faith: TRUE / FALSE ?

This is challenging believers to see they need to be F..... for the Lord

In 2nd Peter ... : ... we also read of how these heretics get right next to us

Jesus in John 10:1 tells of how these people have not come through the G.....

2 – JUDE REVEALS THE CHARACTER BEHIND THIS THREAT

While they think they’ve successfully sneaked they are quite clear on the Lord’s R.....

The phrase “written about” is most likely a reference to:

a) an OT prophecy [] b) Peter’s 2nd letter [] c) a quote of 1st Enoch []

This is most likely a figure of speech for a L..... kept in heaven

Our reading from 2nd Peter shows this in verse

What an apostate shows in his life starts here in his H.....

These men quite clearly show they’re really bad: TRUE / FALSE ?

Such men only T..... God’s grace

3 – JUDE UNCOVERS THE PROCESS OF THIS THREAT

Could there be a more serious charge than at the end of verse 4? YES / NO ?

They were taking the most gracious act of being saved by grace alone and:

a) using it to justify whatever they wanted [] b) so being obedient to God []

“Antinomian” means being against the L..... (cf. Titus : -

Not only do these men attack God’s Word they also attack what makes Jesus the C.....

2nd Peter ... : .. supports seeing this last phrase as being about the Lord Jesus Christ

As you heard what these heretics taught about Jesus Christ you were:

a) puzzled by such a reaction [] b) shocked by people believing this []

Their belief and their lifestyle showed that T..... were their own masters!
